



Announcement of Rajamangala University of Technology Krungthep “No Gift Policy”

According to the constitution of the kingdom of Thailand B.E.2560, Article 50 (10), which stipulates the duties of Thai people to refrain from cooperating with or supporting corruption and misconduct in any form; in conjunction with the Organic Act on Counter Corruption B.E. 2561, Article 128, which prohibits state officials from accepting property or any other benefits, whether or not calculable in monetary value, from any person; and in accordance with the Cabinet Resolution dated 8 December B.E. 2563, approving the Revised National Reform Plan on the Prevention and Suppression of Corruption and Misconduct, which prescribes the implementation of key reform activities, particularly Reform Activity 4: Developing the Thai public sector to be transparent and free from vested interests, with Goal 1, article 1.1 requiring all state officials shall not accept gifts or gratuities of any kind in the performance of their duties (No Gift Policy)

Rajamangala University of Technology Krungthep, as a state organization, recognizes the importance of preventing and combating corruption and misconduct. Therefore, the President, as the highest executive authority, together with all personnel of Rajamangala University of Technology Krungthep, hereby jointly declare that Rajamangala University of Technology Krungthep is an organization in which all state officials shall not accept gifts or gratuities of any kind in the performance of their duties (No Gift Policy). The University is committed to performing its duties with integrity, ethics, and without conflicts of interest in order to prevent corruption and misconduct. All personnel shall strictly comply with the No Gift Policy of Rajamangala University of Technology Krungthep and shall conduct themselves in accordance with the ethical standards for personnel and the code of Ethics of the University, with the aim of fostering a sustainable organizational culture.

The policies are as follows:

1. Personnel of Rajamangala University of Technology Krungthep shall not accept, give, or solicit gifts or gratuities of any kind in connection with the performance of their duties, whether before, during, or after the performance of such duties, and shall not seek to obtain gifts, gratuities, or any unlawful or improper benefits.
2. Expressions of congratulations or goodwill shall be conveyed by signing greeting cards or through online media instead of giving physical gifts, in order to promote an appropriate organizational culture.

This announcement is hereby made known to all concerned and shall be strictly observed.
